Transition Day – Wednesday 5th July 2023

Ahead of transition day we would like to send a reminder of the plans and what to expect from the day. We need your child to arrive between 08:30am and 08:55am in their Primary School uniform. On arrival we will direct them to the Assembly Hall entrance, which is next to the main bike sheds. The students will meet the house team staff and have a presentation from the Principal. They will then participate in lessons and mini sessions around the Academy.

The day will end at 2:30pm, we will allow the students to leave at this time unattended. However, if you have indicated on the transition booking form that you do not want us to let your child go, they will be kept inside the building until you make us aware that you are present.

As you may already be aware there is a scheduled NEU Teacher strike planned for the 5th July 2023, please be assured that we will still be hosting transition day in full. Due to the strike, we can now offer the following as some of our other years will not be present. **All** students will be provided with a **free** hot or cold lunch, which will be inclusive of the option of either Vegetarian, Vegan or Halal meal or sandwich. We will also be providing a snack to all students in break time. Please ensure your child brings a water bottle with them, we have refilling stations they can use. If you have any specific concerns around dietary or allergies, please contact the Academy. Please be assured we have this essential information via the ‘Student Admission Consent Form’, that you have already completed.
