GCSE Results Day 2020

Dear Year 11 Students, Parent and Carers

As you know, GCSE Results Day will go ahead, as previously planned, on **Thursday 20th August**.

As public health restrictions remain in place, we have devised an approach to Results Day, in line with current guidance, that will offer students the opportunity and experience of coming on site to collect their results safely and be congratulated by staff on their achievements.

Results collection and health & safety measures

- GCSE results can be collected by students on the morning of 20th August 2020 from **9am to 12pm** in the Assembly Hall
- The only entry point into school that morning will be the main Snowdon Road entrance, at the top of the drive that leads into the car park
- A queuing system that maintains social distancing guidelines will be in operation, starting from the canteen delivery gate at the top of the drive
- Students will be directed to enter the Assembly Hall, no more than 5 at a time, to collect their results
- Any parents/carers attending in support will be directed down the drive to wait outside the main school entrance
- Hand sanitiser will be available on entry and exit from the Hall
- Wearing a mask/face covering is optional
- Once results have been collected, we respectfully ask that you make your way off site unless a 1:1 guidance conversation is requested to discuss outcomes and/or securing a Post 16 destination

As is always the case, results cannot be relayed via telephone. If students are unable to collect their results personally on the day and would like someone else to collect them on their behalf, we require written authorisation from the student in order to issue their results envelope to a named person, that clearly states their relationship to the student. Written authorisation can be brought in by a third party on the day or submitted beforehand by email to our BMA Exams Officer: Mandie.Armstrong@clf.uk

If it is not possible for a student or an authorised third party to collect GCSE results on Thursday 20th August by or before 12 noon, the results envelope will be posted home.
