



## **Behaviour Expectations – Remote Learning**

Whilst working from home and receiving your lessons remotely, the same high standards of behaviour and respect are required.

Whilst the normal 'Learning Ready' system cannot apply for obvious reasons, set out below are the standards we expect to be upheld, and the sanctions if they are not. Being able to access live lessons in accordance with your timetable is a privilege, and one we couldn't provide in the first national lockdown. It is important that you are making the most of every opportunity to learn, and that you do not prevent others from doing the same.

### **Expectations:**

- Any use of the chat function is kept about school work only
- No swearing or abusive language to be used in the chat function
- If your teacher allows you to unmute, you only do so when asked, and then re-mute straight away
- As standard, cameras should be kept off
- You should only join lessons that are on your timetable, and not try to enter other classes
- You should only join lessons using your Bristol Met account and display name so that your teacher knows you are in the lesson. This also enables the registers of attendance to be accurate.
- You are not to enter personal chats with other students
- Complete work to the same standard, or higher, as you would in a normal lesson

### **Sanctions:**

1<sup>st</sup> - You will receive one verbal/typed warning regarding your conduct during a live lesson

2<sup>nd</sup> – If you continue with the behaviour, your teacher will remove you from the live lesson

3<sup>rd</sup> – If you continue to disrupt the live lesson from outside (eg continuing to use the chat function), then you will be removed from the Teams platform for a full working week.

At every stage of the sanction process, house teams and safeguarding will be made aware. If a pattern of behaviour appears across a number of live lessons, then you also run the risk of being temporarily removed from the Teams platform for a longer period of time. Contact will also be made home from step 2 onwards to discuss your behaviour.

When removed from the Teams platform, you will be expected to complete the work set on SMHW, without having the ability to attend live lessons.

By logging in to your Office365 account, you are agreeing to the expectations and sanctions laid out above.

If you are unsure what is allowed in a lesson please politely ask your classroom teacher to clarify their expectations.
