Local agencies continue to work closely with all educational settings to ensure young people remain safeguarded across our city and we will continue to pass on any relevant advice and information for parents/carers as and when it is made available to us.

As always, please do speak to your young people about any concerns they may have and encourage them to speak to their Tutor, House Team or Safeguarding Team (or any trusted adult within the Academy) about any concerns or information they may wish to share with us and we will support them (and families) to process recent events.
