This will give you the opportunity to hear from me and other key member of Staff such as your child's Head of House, Senior Leaders and the Transition Leader – Mr Cooley. This would also provide an opportunity for you to ask some questions.

This can be a fantastic opportunity for Students to come to the school over the Summer and spend some time seeing how a day at the school would feel.
