Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well.

I am writing to inform you of some small but important updates to our school uniform policy, following consultation with students and staff.

Blazers and Jumpers

We are gradually phasing out the MET school blazer. However, students currently in Years 8–11 (for the 2024–25 academic year) may continue to wear and purchase the blazer until they leave the school. The blazer will be fully phased out by September 2028, when the current Year 7 students reach Year 11.

- All students must wear either a MET blazer or a navy jumper with the MET logo.
- Students may wear both items together if they wish.
- New Year 7 students must wear the MET navy jumper and should not purchase a blazer.

Trousers, Skirts, and Shorts

Students have the following uniform options:

- Charcoal or black tailored shorts
- A black pleated skirt worn to the knee *
- Black trousers (worn on the waist)

These items can be purchased from any outlet, provided they meet our uniform standards.

*Please note: Ankle-length skirts worn for religious or cultural reasons are still permitted.

Other Uniform Requirements

- Shoes: Plain black school shoes (can be purchased from any retailer)
- Shirts/Blouses: Plain white shirt or blouse
- School Tie: Navy tie with the MET logo (available from Student Reception or Doug Hillard Sports)
- PE Kit: To be purchased from Doug Hillard Sports
