Leavers' assembly

Prom

GCSE Results Day

GCSE results will be issued on **Thursday 25th August 2022**. The Results Day experience is both personal and congratulatory, an opportunity to collect results from school and meet with peers and teachers that are present. GCSE results can be collected by students from **9am to 12pm** in the Assembly Hall. The only entry point into school that morning will be the main Snowdon Road entrance, at the top of the drive that leads into the car park.

As is always the case, results cannot be relayed via telephone. If students are unable to collect their results personally on the day and would like someone else to collect them on their behalf, we will require written authorisation from the student in order to issue their results envelope to a named person, that clearly states their relationship to the student.
