Subject	Tasks

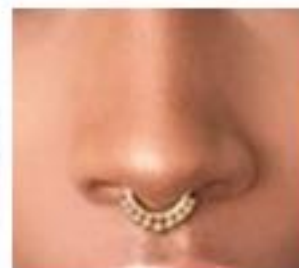
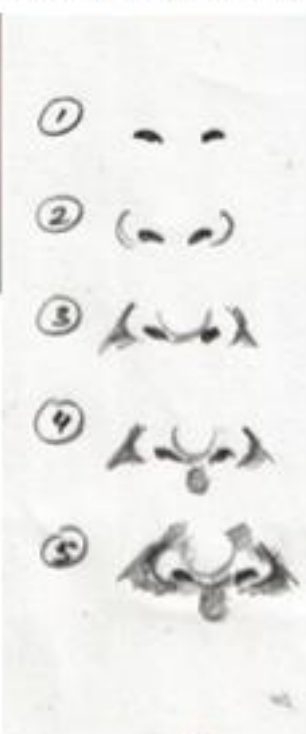
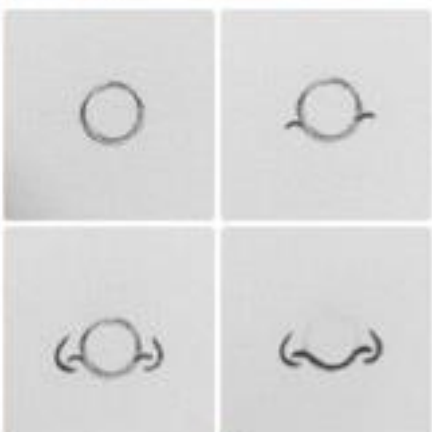
- Press lightly at first

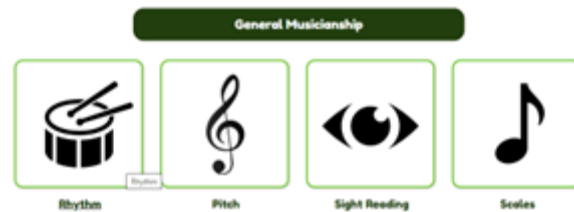
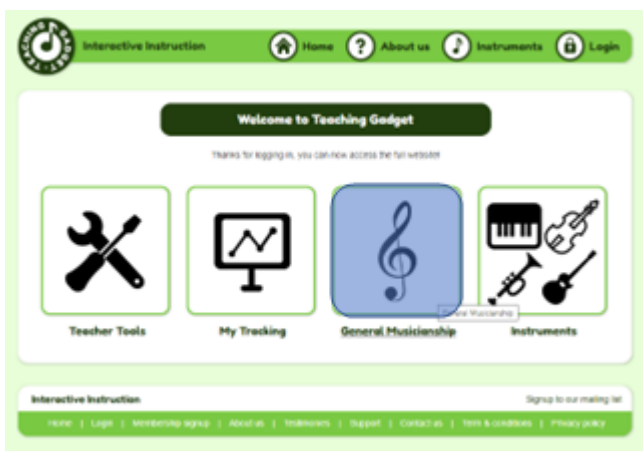
