Subject	Tasks

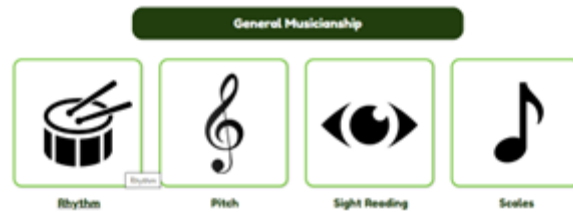
